
A "Site Map" is a scaled drawing showing all existing structures, proposed construction, and relation to all existing private or public roads, existing utilities, utility or other easements & rights-of-way. Your site map should include <u>all</u> of the following:

- ① Property Dimensions (the lot size) in sq. feet · · →
- ② Dimensions and square footage of all existing structures <-->
- ③ Dimensions and square footage of the proposed structure ← →
- ④ Impervious structures and their dimensions (i.e. sidewalks, paved driveways, concrete patios, etc) ←→
- ⑤ Distance between structures and all property lines ← → →
- ⑥ Distance between all structures ◆ ◆ ◆



Double-ended arrows () indicate where a measurement (in feet) should be included by the owner and/or Applicant. If there are any questions, please ask the Zoning Officer or office staff.
